

# Haiti Missions

Greetings from the Crossroads International Headquarters (i.e. our office);

Thank you so much for your interest in missions. There is so much work to be done around the world and we praise God for your willingness to help out and see His Kingdom grow.

The country of Haiti is only a two hour plane ride from Miami. It is the poorest county in our hemisphere and considered a fifth world country. There is no hope of an agricultural boom in the next ten years. However, there are people who are bringing the hope of Jesus Christ to Haiti. Crossroads Worldwide has the privilege of working with New Missions in Haiti. New Missions has been working in the Leogane Plain of Haiti for the past 24 years. Since its founding, they have started over 20 churches and schools ministering to over 6000 children. In June we will lead a group to Haiti to work in local villages. They we will participate in giving physicals to students, ministering in the villages, and helping to upgrade the different parts of the church and school. You will also have the chance to sponsor a child and meet his or her family. The trip will truly change your perspective of needs in the world.

# Haiti Missions Financial Details

Cost: \$1,200\*

Airfare: \$700~ this includes all round trip airfare to and from designated country as well as any domestic airfare within country.

Other Expenses: \$450~ this covers the cost of transportation in country such as busses, vans, trains, etc. It also covers the cost of most food and housing while on mission, and the cost of paying translators, drivers, guides, etc.

Administrative Fees: \$50~ this is used to off set the cost of planning your trip. It is also used to pay for your team leader's expenses. Any extra funds will be put into a separate account that will be used to help support long-term missionaries that Crossroads Worldwide may send out in the future. \*\*
