Navajo Missions Financial Details

Cost: \$1,100*

Airfare: \$550– this includes all round trip airfare to and from designated location.

Other Expenses: \$500– this covers the cost of other transportation such as busses, vans, etc (including gas). This will cover any supplies needed while on site. It also covers the cost of most food and all housing while on mission.

Administrative Fees: \$50– this is used to off set the cost of planning your trip. It is also used to pay for your team leader's expenses. Any extra funds will be put into a separate account that will be used to help support long-term missionaries that Crossroads Worldwide may send out in the future. **
